-Every month (starting the first week of school) each student will be required to bring in individually wrapped snack- enough for the whole class.

-Students will have homework every night. Keep extra pencils, crayons and colored pencils at home to complete work.

-The Fitzpatrick school uniform is Navy blue pants and a white or yellow shirt. Students are able to wear navy blue gym sweatpants every day.

Sneakers are required for gym and recommended for every day.

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Supplies List for Second Grade

- 4 hard-backed marble composition books, sewn binding with child's name. No spirals or binders please.
- 5 sturdy folders, with pockets, with name
- 1 ream of copy paper (500 sheets)
- 200 white index cards (size 3 by 5)
- 1 pair of headphones/earbuds (in a baggie labeled with the student's name) These may need to be replaced during the year, if broken. We use them every day.
- 5 sheet protectors
- 1 large sturdy school bag (no wheels please)
- 1 rag or clean old sock to use as eraser
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 1 container of Clorox/Lysol disinfecting wipes
- 2 large boxes of tissues

- 1 large zippered pencil case (**no plastic boxes please**) with the following items inside:
 - o 4 # 2 **sharpened** pencils (no mechanical pencils)
 - o 1 box of 24 crayons with name
 - o 2 big erasers with name
 - o 2 glue sticks with name (no liquid glue please)
 - o 3 Expo dry erase markers with name (not yellow please)

Make sure to have at home: **plenty of extra sharpened #2 pencils**, erasers, glue sticks, crayons, and dry erase markers to put in the pencil case as your child uses the others. Also keep a ruler, sharpeners, and child scissors at home for homework.

Some additional supplies may be requested later.

Safety is the number one priority of my program and I am sure you will agree that your child's safety should come first. I am asking that all children be prepared for class by wearing sneakers. Sneakers will provide the best traction needed to safely perform the activities we do in class. The School District of Philadelphia policy requires students to wear sneakers for gym class; students may not participate in the program without them.
